Wellbeing Lincs is a countywide service focused on improving the lives of adults across Lincolnshire; empowering them to live independently in their own homes for as long as they are able.

Hospitals, GP's, Adult Social Care and other statutory services are facing significant pressure and demand, particularly through the challenge of Delayed Transfers of Care (DToc). Reducing delays in hospital discharge is a national challenge and one that the Wellbeing Lincs Service seeks to actively support in Lincolnshire.

The Housing and Hospital Development officers will lead on developing, evaluating and continuously strengthening our links with relevant services to facilitate the prompt discharge of patients from Lincolnshire based acute and community hospital settings.

The post holder will have a geographical remit across the designated locality area. However, it is important that specific geographical locations are not considered in isolation. Travel will be required across and outside of Lincolnshire as required, to develop relationships, pathways and protocols with hospitals within which Lincolnshire residents are accessing treatment. Each post holder will be required to work in an agile manner, co-locating with teams across the county as required. Flexible working will be supported and encouraged.
